Of manifestatie

Huntenkunst is an art manifestation, intended for professionally working artists and gallery owners. The emphasis is on the artists and their work.

During the weekend in May, 270 artists from the Netherlands and abroad will present their work.

The origin

In 1993, Huntenkunst was held for the first time in the hamlet of Veldhunten. Gratefully, the Uiftse Gallery at the Books was used. The character of pioneers in culture was further underlined by the fact that the first fair took place in a tent, where more than 80 artists from various countries exhibited their work. In the meantime, the manifestation has grown into an important festival for contemporary visual art, which takes place annually in May.

Vast concept

Huntenkunst wants to offer a platform to artists from all over the world. The event therefore offers plenty of opportunity to make contacts. In addition, the organization wants to arouse the public's interest in contemporary visual art. The aim is to offer diversity both in style and technique. The presence of the artist gives the visitor the opportunity to exchange ideas with the maker. The international character of the fair is reflected in the fact that thirty countries are represented. In addition to the Netherlands, artists come from Germany, Hungary, Belgium, France, South Korea, Finland and Russia. Interesting are the various influences that can be discovered in connection with the origin of the artists. This year there are more than 60 percent new participants, which continues to make Huntenkunst interesting and surprising.

Latvia theme country

Every year, a country is declared a theme country. This year, nine artists from Latvia are exhibiting their work. In the center of the exhibition hall will be the Latvian pavilion. At the same time, they also exhibit in the Gallery at the DRU Industrial Park. The exhibition is scheduled from 15 May to 6 July. Don de Jong takes care of the transport of the works of art. During the opening (23 May at 16.00 hrs) the ambassador of Latvia Mrs. Solita Aboltina will speak.

Artez at Huntenkunst

The project with graduated students from Artez Arnhem was successful last year. There will also be special attention for young artists at the upcoming event. A special pavilion has been designed again, in which recently graduated artists from Artez can exhibit their work. We want to offer young artists an opportunity to promote themselves and to attract young visitors with them.

Where Hunten Art Comes to Life

The SSP hall is a former production hall (5,500 m²), where the famous DRU pan was once manufactured. At the end of May, an 'art village' will be built here. The interior ensures that the viewer keeps walking into a new exhibition space. The 'art streets' produce a society that puts colour and form first. You are

literally somewhere else, somewhere where wonder and beauty predominate and share the inner world of your fellow man.
